

Terms of Use MoodApp

Last updated 25 October, 2021

These are the terms of use ("**Terms of Use**") for an app developed by a researcher of Ghent University ("**MoodApp**" or "**the app**"). Ghent University is a Public Institution with Legal Personality under Belgian law, whose registered office is located at Sint-Pietersnieuwstraat 25, 9000 Gent, and which is registered in the Crossroads Bank for Enterprises under number 0248.015.142 ("**Ghent University**", "**we**", "**us**", or "**our**"),

The MoodApp is intended to collect subjective medical information in combination with people's motivation to perform in physical activity. The app is designed as part of a research study of the research group "WAVES" of the Department of Information Technology, Ghent University ("**the study**"). You can only download, install and use the app when you were invited to participate in the study and after agreeing to these Terms of Use.

These Terms of Use apply to any access or use to the MoodApp and to all information or use thereof.

ACCEPTANCE AND MODIFICATION OF THE TERMS OF USE

These Terms of Use constitute a legally binding agreement between you and Ghent University concerning your access to and use of the MoodApp. By accessing and by using the app, you are deemed to have read, understood, and accepted to be bound by these Terms of Use. The app may only be used in accordance with these Terms of Use. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE WITH ALL OF THESE TERMS OF USE, THEN YOU ARE EXPRESSLY PROHIBITED FROM PARTICIPATING IN THE STUDY AND USING THE APP AND YOU MUST DISCONTINUE USE IMMEDIATELY AND REFRAIN FROM ANY FURTHER USAGE.

The app is intended for users who are at least 18 years old. Persons under the age of 18 are not permitted to access or use for the app.

Ghent University may adapt, modify or supplement the content of these Terms of Use at any time without announcement or notice. We ask the user to regularly review the Terms of Use. This version of the Terms of Use was last modified on 25 October, 2021.

CONTENT OF THE APP

The information provided on or via our app is of a general nature and is not adapted to personal or specific circumstances of a particular person, company or other entity. The information cannot be regarded as personal, professional, legal advice or its equivalent. The use of the information on our app is at your own risk.

SOFTWARE AND DOWNLOAD

This app is only available for mobile Android devices. Depending on the version of the app, the app can only be installed on Android version 7.0 or higher. Check with the researchers what the minimum Android version of

your device has to be. Refer to the instruction manual for information about the installation and operation of the app.

The app is only available for download through the link provided on the website shared with possible participants. You are only allowed to download and install the app when you were invited by Ghent University to participate in the study. Refrain from downloading the app or remove the app immediately from your device in case you were not invited to participate.

You have the right to terminate your participation to the study at any time. The actions required to terminate your participation are explained in the instruction manual. Upon your request to terminate your account, the app will deactivate or delete your account and information from our active databases.

You can also always contact the researchers through ine.coppens@ugent.be when encountering technical difficulties. Please also report any errors present in the app. We cannot guarantee the app is error-free, malware-free or virus-free and that it cannot be hacked. We cannot guarantee that the app does not cause any problems when installed on your smartphone like battery draining, problems when receiving notifications, unexpected shutdown of the app, wrong location or step data being collected or errors when making connection to the used services. If the app is causing too many problems on your smartphone, please report this to the researchers and uninstall the app from your device.
